Course Summary

This follow up to the morning course “Introduction to Minor Tooth Movement for The Cosmetic Dentist”, will focus on utilizing the Invisalign system to improve patients smiles in a cosmetic dental practice.

- Indications and treatment planning.
- Aligner limitations and utilization of the Tooth Movement Assessment.
- 7 things that must be reviewed with an Invisalign candidate before every case.
- Detailed Clincheck Analysis – how to reduce complications and treatment times.
- Foundation cases that provide predictable results and build confidence.
- Monitoring, trouble shooting, and mid-course techniques for success.
- Finishing and Retention.
- Advanced treatment planning for cosmetic restorative cases.
- Overlapping or “stacking” treatment for increased efficiency.
- Case review: attendees are encouraged to bring models and/or photos of cases for analysis at end of class.
